

Notice for CGPA Conversion

In regard to CGPA system, candidates whose mark sheets do not reflect the grand total marks, as well as individual total marks are asked to calculate their individual total marks as illustrated below:

Suppose full marks (as stated in the syllabus) is -900

% of marks (after converting CGPA to %) – 63.7

So, individual marks = % of marks obtained x full marks

$$= 63.7\% \times 900$$

$$= 63.7/100 \times 900 = 573.3$$
