

The speakers Dr Mahua Basu Mallik and Prof Goutam Pahari gave wonderful presentations.







POSTER PRESENTATION BY STUDENTS THROUGH ONLINE MODE ON 3RD JANUARY 2022










STUDENTS' WEEK - JANUARY 4TH 2022











