INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF PROGRAMME

Date: 10.08.2026

Subject: Observance of 14th August as the “Day of Remembrance of the Partition of Bengal and its Tragic Consequences” – Instructions for preparation and implementation of the programme

In view of the communication received from Baba Saheb Ambedkar Education University (BSAEU) regarding the observance of 14th August as a Day of Remembrance of the Partition of Bengal, the following instructions are hereby issued for necessary preparation and implementation of the programme at Government College of Education, Burdwan.

SC, PK, SK, Byapti, NP, RG, BB, SS shall ensure proper planning, execution and documentation of the event.

1. Proposed Programme:

The programme shall include:

I. Welcome Address

Address by Principal Dr. Sreetanuka Nath regarding ‘Remembrance of the Partition of Bengal and its Tragic Consequences’

II. A brief historical presentation/documentary on the Partition

III. Presentations/speeches by staff /students:

Guiding topics may be:

- A. displacement and migration;
- B. loss and suffering of the people;
- C. social, cultural and economic consequences;
- D. courage, resilience and sacrifices of the affected people;

IV. Recitation/reading of appropriate literary excerpts, poems or memoirs reflecting the experience of Partition

V. Interactive discussion/experience-sharing session

VI. Observance through a moment of silence in remembrance of those who suffered and lost their lives

VII. Vote of Thanks

The programme should maintain a historical, educational and commemorative character, with due sensitivity and respect for the experiences of people affected by Partition.

2. Student Participation

Students should participate actively through speeches, presentations, poster/display activities, recitation, essay writing or other suitable academic and cultural activities.

3. Display/Exhibition

A small display/exhibition on the Partition of Bengal may be arranged, containing photographs, maps, newspaper reports, timelines, literary excerpts and other authentic historical materials. Particular emphasis may be given to the experience of West Bengal and the people displaced or otherwise affected by Partition.

4. Documentation

The entire programme shall be properly documented. The following may be maintained:

- Programme schedule;
- Attendance sheet;
- Photographs;
- Video recording;
- Copies of presentations/posters/materials;
- Brief report of the programme;
- social-media coverage.
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5. Uploading on College Website

As directed by BSAEU, the video recording and a brief report/documentation of the programme should be uploaded on the official website of the College on the same day, i.e. 14.08.2026.

SS and RG shall make necessary arrangements in advance to ensure timely uploading.

6. Submission to University

SS and RG to keep ready a copy of the video recording and brief report/documentation for forwarding by e-mail to the Joint Secretary, Lok Bhavan, West Bengal, as directed by the University.

7. Responsibility for Timely Completion

All concerned faculty members, staff and students are requested to extend full cooperation. The Programme Team shall ensure that all preparations are completed before 14.08.2026 and that the programme and subsequent documentation are completed within the stipulated time.
