- iv) Debate on the topic, “Today, Digital Awareness and Alertness should be a part of the Formal Curriculum”.

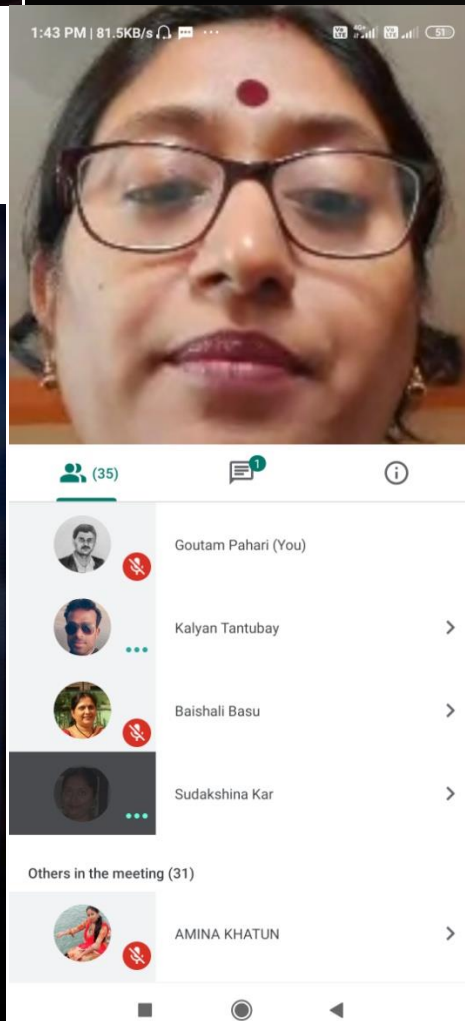
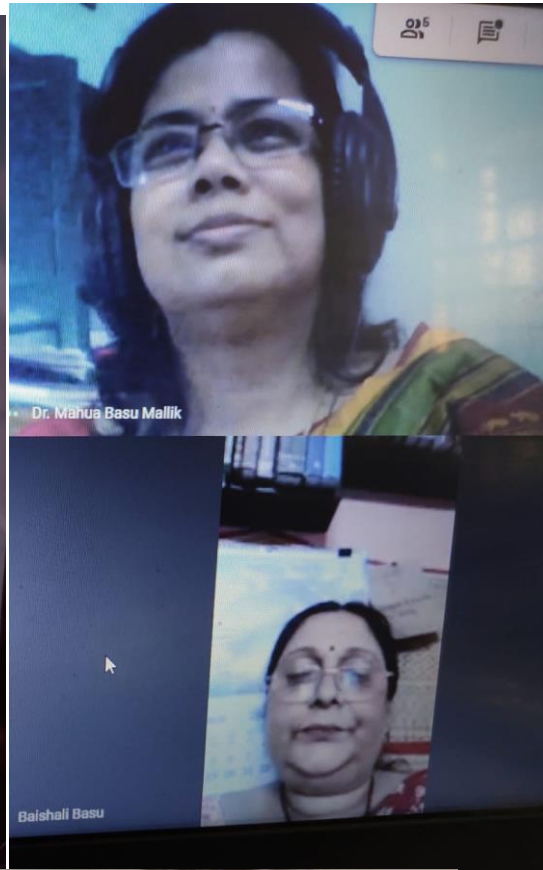
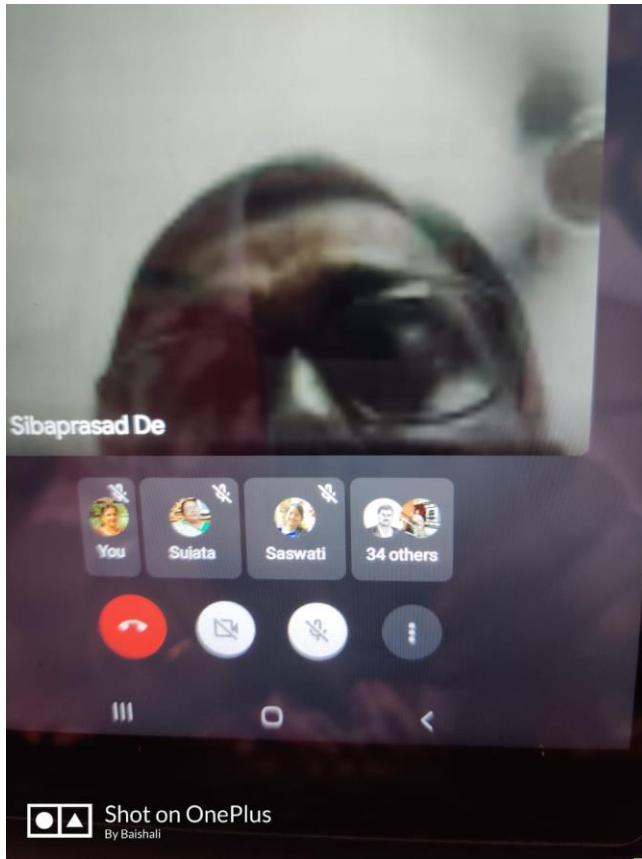
The students of session 2018-2020 and session 2019-2021 participated with whole-hearted interest and enthusiasm.

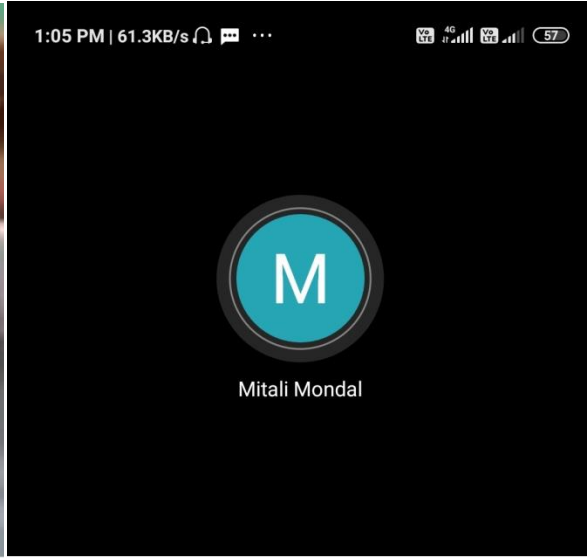

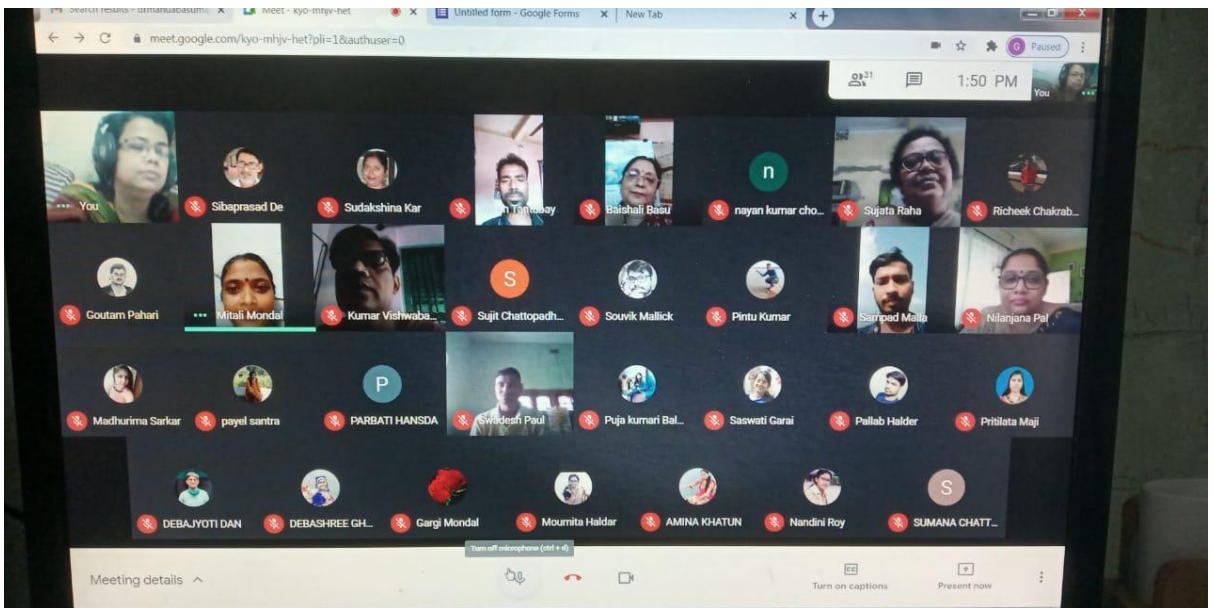
